It's hard to believe, but we are gearing up for Registration for the 2017-2018 school year! Registration sheets for next school year will be distributed to families in the month of January.

When can I officially register for the 2017-2018 school year?

Registration for current Weekday School families will be held on Monday, February 6th from 8:30 am-1:30 pm. New families, as well as current families, are welcome to register their children on Tuesday, February 7th from 8:30 am-1:30 pm. Tuesday, February 7th is also Open House Day from 9:00 am-12:00 noon. While this is typically a time for new families to look at our program, we also extend the invitation to current families who might be interested in looking at other classrooms. In addition, members of the Weekday School Team will be present to answer questions, and Ms. Lara and Ms. Carrie will be giving tours of the school and its classrooms.

What do I need to bring with me to registration?

We will be collecting Registration forms, Commitment Fees, and recording birth certificate information (for new students only).
