Gearing Up for 2014-2015

Can you believe it? Registration for the 2014-2015 year is fast approaching!

Listed below are some helpful guidelines to see you through the registration process.

FAQ's About Registration

Q: Will I need to bring my child's birth certificate?

A: We do not need to view birth certificates for students who are currently enrolled. We will need to view birth certificates for new students.

Q: What about health forms?

A: Health forms are valid for one calendar year. You will receive notification of when your child's form expires. The Department of Social Services has a new requirement wherein we are required to have updated immunization records every six months for children ages 2 years and under.

Q: What can I expect to pay at registration?

A: Registration fee of \$55 per child, or \$80 per family is due at the time of registration. A deposit of \$100 to hold your child's spot will be due in June.

Q: What factors determine class placement?

A: Chronological age is certainly a factor, as well as developmental age. Since we operate based on developmentally appropriate practices, our priority is to place children where they will be most successful.
