

Our school is accredited by NAEYC. This framework and NAEYC-approved Creative Curriculum® calls for our teachers to use their understanding of child development to plan activities, create a learning environment, and establish a schedule that is developmentally appropriate.

Our staff strives to meet each child at his/her current level of cognitive, language, physical, spiritual and social development. Our goals:

- 1. To provide high quality learning in a safe and nurturing environment.
- 2. To offer a developmentally appropriate curriculum for all areas of a child's development.
- 3. To create a learning environment that encourages lifelong pleasure in exploration and discovery.

## ENROLLMENT AT THE WEEKDAY SCHOOL

Enrollment is open to children ages 6 weeks through 5 years. Several class offerings are available depending on the child's age:

2 days/week: Tues./Thurs. 3 days/week: Mon./Wed./Fri. 4 days/week: Mon./Tues./Wed./Thurs. 5 days/week: Mon./Tues./Wed./Thurs./Fri.

Our school year is September through May.

Arrival time is 9 a.m. for all students. Dismissal begins at 12:45 for our youngest students, with staggered dismissals ending at 1 p.m. for our four and five year olds.

## SAFETY FIRST

A safe environment is a primary concern of the Weekday School staff, director and First Presbyterian Church. We do everything we can to ensure your child's safety through facility inspections, routine maintenance, and consistent policies and procedures.

For your child's safety, and to comply with our NAEYC accreditation, children must be dropped off and picked up in person.

## COMMUNICATION

Communication is vital to maintaining our family atmosphere. A teacher and director's newsletter are sent home monthly. Conferences are held yearly and other times as needed.

Our drop off and pick up times offer a wonderful "check in moment" regarding your child. We want to know and understand your child, so feel free to communicate with your child's teacher!
