Lara Shares "The 'Write' Stuff in Preschool"

This is an example of pre-representational writing. To a preschool-aged child, this can "say:"

- "My name is Billy."
- "I am playing outside."
- "I like ice cream."

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This is an example of intentional representation with multiple symbol systems. To a preschool-aged child, this can "say:"

- "My name is Billy."
- "I am playing outside."
- "I like ice cream."

I LIC IS KREM This is an example of intentional representation with more "invented" spelling of matching letters to sounds. To a preschool-aged child, this "says:"

"I like ice cream."

These are examples of a child's natural progression of learning to express thoughts and ideas to communicate a written message. At the Weekday School, we provide opportunities for children to draw, write, and journal. Children are encouraged to follow these steps: (1) Think (develop a thought or idea to communicate); (2) Draw (express that thought or idea in pictorial representation); (3) Write (use symbols, letters or representational letter forms to write about the picture).
