Dear Weekday School Families:

It's hard to believe that registration for the next school year begins in February of the current one! For some of our families, preschool days are waning and registration and planning has begun for entrance into public or private kindergartens. This can be a time of excitement as anticipation of entering into a different phase of education gets closer. There may also be feelings of uncertainty. Families will experience a time of transition. Parents may entertain thoughts of "readiness."

Readiness, by definition, is a willingness or eagerness which motivates action. Readiness means being prepared for the next task or step. "Readiness is:

- a child with strong relationships to significant adults, and the ability to form attachments.
- a child who loves books, reading, and being read to.
- a child who is infinitely curious about the world around him.
- a child who speaks up for himself, with skills to talk to people of all ages.
- a child on a continuum of learning.

Readiness might <u>not</u> be all of these at once." This list was posted on January 29, 2013 by Emily Plank, an early childhood educator (<a href="http://abundantlifechildren">http://abundantlifechildren</a>).

We begin to nurture this readiness when our children enter preschool, whether as an infant or five year old. Staff members intentionally and thoughtfully observe, then plan activities and provide materials which support children's physical, social/emotional, cognitive, and language development. Through play, exploration, experimentation, and engagement in meaningful activities, children begin to see themselves as learners. It's not as much about teachers providing the answers as it is about teachers asking the questions that will motivate and inspire children to continue to discover and learn. This approach relies on the mindfulness and expertise of the teaching staff, whose knowledge and observation of the development of children, directs curriculum planning to assist children in their current stages of development and help scaffold them toward the next developmental stage.

### Dear Parents:

There were two incidents this week where an individual was displaying inappropriate behavior while on church property. In each case, church staff members immediately responded and took the appropriate steps to ensure that the individual was removed from church premises. Neither incident was deemed an imminent threat to children or staff members. Both incidents have been reviewed and discussed among church staff as well as the Weekday School advisory team.

In addition to the plans we already have in place to provide safety and security to our families and staff, we are exploring other ways to increase building security. One of those ways is to alter the time that the back door is locked. We will now lock the door immediately after drop off time (9:15) and unlock just prior to pick up time (12:45). In addition, there is a buzzer on the front door designed to alert church staff of anyone entering the building. We have noticed that some parents have turned the buzzer off due to the sound it makes. Please help us by leaving the buzzer on at all times.

We must all be vigilant about the safety of our families wherever we are. Please be sure that your child is supervised at all times, in the hallways and in the bathrooms. In addition, take your child's hand as you enter and exit the building. Our parking lot is very busy. If you witness an individual displaying inappropriate behavior, report it immediately to a Weekday School staff or church staff member. If you should have questions about incidents that are reported, please call the Weekday school at 662-7588 or the church office at 662-3824. This is a helpful way to obtain the most recent and accurate facts.

We assure you that the school and church staff are committed to providing a safe physical and social environment for our children so that optimum learning may take place.
